Step – 2 - Login with registered email id and password

Step – 3 – Download the hall ticket.

- ❖ Click on given links to attempt the online exam during specified timings only.

- **Back** button is **NOT AVAILABLE** to view previous questions & answers. Once submitted, no more changes can be made.
- please click **Submit** to complete the exam.

- **Don't refresh the page or don't press the Back button during the test.**
- Timer will start when the first question appears on the screen. After completion of time (50mins) the screen will log off automatically.
(However answered questions will be saved and submitted automatically)
- No extra time will be given as it is a web based online exam.
