How to apply –

Registration by School -

- **Step – 1** – School will register with branch details. (School name will be displayed to students for applying themselves)
- **Step – 2** - Log in and provide the students details in given format and complete the payment process.

School will pay to Sanskrit Olympiads Rs. 130/- only per student and the remaining Rs.20/-for school Infrastructural support and postal charges. (If any)

Step – 3 – Download the study material and as share with students

➤ Registration by students individually –

Step – 1 – Register with your name and details

Step – 2 - Login and select your school name with branch. (If not found in the list, shall contact at school only.)

Step – 3 - Pay 150/- and download the study material.

Level-2: No Extra Fee for 2nd Level due to Covid-19 effect

Exam Structure:

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd Language Sanskrit Students of classes 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 are eligible to participate in this examination.
- Syllabus and Study Material is suitable for the students of CBSE / ICSE / SSC and various other State boards curriculum.
- Sanskrit Olympiads - 2021 will be conducted in 2 levels.
- 1st level for all who register for this exam.
- 2nd level for only those students who secure 80% and above in the 1st level.

1st level : – Online Exam

- Date of Examination : 10-12-2021 (Subject to change)
Staggered timings will be given for each class
- Exam. Centre : Respective school / Home.
- Results : 2nd week of January 2022 (Subject to change)

2nd level: - Online Exam

- Date of Examination : 01-02-2022 (Subject to change)
Staggered timings will be given for each class
- Exam centre : Respective school / Home
- Results : 3rd Week of February 2022 (Subject to change)

Exam Pattern:

- Medium of the Exam will be Samskritam.
- Objective type test will be conducted for each class with 60 questions for 60 Marks.
- No negative marking for wrong answers in level-1
- But there will be negative marking in 2nd level for wrong answer.

How to get 1st level Syllabus & Material:

- Students are requested to download the book from website only. After payment is done can be download the material of particular class.

➤ Sanskrit Olympiads Syllabus is separate for each class. Please refer to the syllabus provided on website.

2nd level Syllabus & Material:

- Additional material would be uploaded on our website for the students qualified for 2nd level exam.
- Always need to check our website for more updates.

Results announcement :-

- Results will be posted on Website www.sanskritolympiads.com
- Schools can download the results with 6 digits school code which will be given by Sanskrit Olympiads/ your registered login credentials
- Students can check the results with hall ticket number.

Details of Awards:

- Top 2 rankers* at National Level of each class will be awarded with a **Headset + Trilingual pictorial dictionary of Samskritam + Memento + Medal + Merit certificate.**
- Top 2 rankers* at State Level of each class will be awarded with **Science in Sanskrit book + Samskrita chitrakosha + Medal + Merit certificate.**
- The rest of the 2nd level students of all Classes will get a Medal (E-Certificate can be downloaded)
- Students who secure 36 above marks in level-1 exam will get merit certificate.
- **E-Certificates will be given for 1st and 2nd level students.(Except State and National toppers)**

Terms and Conditions for ranking:

- When more than 2 students get an equal top score in 2nd Level Exam, priority for awarding ranks will be according to the marks acquired in the following specified order of syllabus division like Shabdhas, Dhatu Prayoga and correction of sentences.
- In case it is difficult to decide the toppers with the above mentioned process, **Speaking Skills (Oral test) will be tested for those particular candidates only.**

➤ The schools Which do registration with minimum no. of 100 Students for Sanskrit Olympiads Exam-2021, will be awarded with ‘Best Encouragement Award –
